OVERVIEW

The Lutheran Musculoskeletal Center (LMC) is the newest addition to the Lutheran Health Network in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

LMC is a 39-bed Orthopaedic Hospital located in the 100 acre Lutheran Medical Park on Jefferson Boulevard at I-69 Exit 102.

The LMC is located next to Lutheran Hospital, a 400-bed facility. Also located on the campus are the Rehabilitation Hospital of Fort Wayne, four medical office buildings and a child care center.

PATIENT REGISTRATION

Registration for PAT and surgical services 6:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday to Friday.

SURGERY

The operative suite consists of six rooms. Pre-operative and post-operative care is provided. The surgery suite is integrated providing for both inpatient and outpatient procedures.

MEDICAL SUPPORT SERVICES

Medical support services are leased from Lutheran Hospital and include Case Management, Ethical Consultation Team, Health Sciences Library, Medical Staff Services, Nutritional Services, Pastoral Care, Quality Management, Records Management, Safety and Security, Radiology, Respiratory Therapy and Laboratory.
